
## **Robert Wilkinson**

This workshop in applying the Sabian Symbols will open a deeper and wider view of their meaning in a natal or progressed chart, as well as the transits. We'll explore what they are and their internal structure in the signs. Then we'll apply them to outer planet transits to give a sense of the themes being played out in the "real world," and explore how aspects between transits stimulate certain symbol themes which show the lessons of that time. Then we'll use the Sabian Symbols to analyze the charts of those in attendance, looking at key natal chart points and applying aspect harmonics to see lessons related to those planets.
