***Working with Higher Dimensions in Natal Charts***

***Integrating Harmonic Aspects into the Material World***

There is an ongoing dance between learning new astrological techniques and actually applying them in our work with clients. How many techniques can we bring into a consultation? What are tried and true methods to improve our chart reading skills and hone our consultation skills? Participants of this workshop will explore the dynamics of client sessions, the wide variety of goals astrologers have for doing client charts, and some basic pitfalls that we can learn to avoid. Rick will guide us through several different approaches to chart work and share his own goals and methods. Using concepts from "Quantum Astrology," you will learn Rick's method of prioritizing the importance of different factors in a reading. As we explore aspect synthesis, we will open the door to using chart patterns and harmonic resonance that relies on quintiles, septiles, octiles, noviles, and more. Prepare to have your mind widened by these aspects. Once you begin to look at them, you'll wonder how you ever did a chart without them.

Volunteers will be taken from class for real-time live demonstrations of these techniques. Class participants will gain a fresh perspective that can be incorporated into their client work, no matter what their current skill level and regardless of what specific techniques comprise the body of their work.

**Bio:** Rick Levine is a founding member of the Kepler College Board of Trustees and co-author of eight years of Barnes and Noble's annual Your Astrology Guide. Levine daily horoscopes were read by millions for nearly 20 years, appearing on Yahoo, AOL, Huffington Post, LA Times and many other sites. Currently, tens of thousands of astrology students from around the world view his teachings on YouTube every month. He received the "International Astrologer of the Year" award in 2018 at the Krishnamurti Institute of Astrology's 28th International Astrology Conference in Kolkata, India. In March 2019 Levine was honored with Turkey's prestigious "Fomalhaut Award" for astrological excellence. In 2022 he received two ISAR awards for his high level of social media contributions.
